- □ Original Conduct and Character Certificate from where the qualifying examination has been passed or from concerned Embassy or Foreign Ministry (if not submitted with the application form)
- Original Certificate of Medical Fitness to be signed by a Registered Medical Practitioner holding a degree not lower than MBBS in the format as given in Appendix (Refer Admission Brochure). (if not submitted with the application form)
