Participants should have access to the following to fully benefit from the workshop.

1. (a) Camera with minimum full HD shooting capabilities (minimum resolution 1920x1080p).  
b) If in case you may not have access to a professional camera then you may use a good mobile camera too with Full HD or 4K capabilities.
2. Good speed internet to be able to attend the workshop without disruptions on Google meet.
3. (a) For editing video in full HD we recommend **8 GB RAM** at the absolute minimum, but 16 GB and above will make the workflow faster. If you shoot at 4K resolution then we recommend at least 16 GB RAM.  
(b) Other than that a good CPU and decent graphics card which can handle the edit.  
(c) Empty storage space in the hard disk.


