- Leadership/expert talks: Various experts/leaders in the area of innovation and entrepreneurship
- Experience Sharing: MIC alumni who established their enterprise share their experience.
- Mentoring: During all five days and also through the portal round the year
- Pitching: The pitching of participants will be evaluated, and experts will give them tips for improvement.
- Networking and connecting opportunity: Spend time with like-minded people and forge partnerships with other startups, partners and other players within the startup ecosystem.

The bootcamp will be organized for 5 days physically. AICTE will provide food & accommodation.
