

- Font: Times New Roman, Size 12 points, spacing 1.5, in MS word, top and bottom margin 1" and left and right margin 1.5".
- References should be written in APA Style (7th edition).
- The title of the topic, author's affiliation and e-mail id should be placed in italics with center alignment after title. In case of joint author, each author must register individually.
